Exhibition: Chalkie Davies: the NME years – National Museum Cardiff – 9 May–6 September 2015.

Welsh-born Chalkie Davies joined the Rock'n'Roll Circus in '73 after photographing David Bowie's last night as Ziggy Stardust. He worked as a staff photographer at the NME (New Musical Express) from '75-'79 shooting numerous covers and features on the most influential artists from that era, including Elvis Costello, Nick Lowe, Ian Dury, Debbie Harry, Paul McCartney, The Clash, The Ramones and The Rolling Stones.

In '80 he helped launch The Face magazine with his old NME editor Nick Logan, shooting many cover stories. During this period he also shot record covers for Thin Lizzy, Elvis Costello, The Pretenders, The Specials, Pete Townshend and David Bowie. He also made a series of formal portraits of many of the best musicians from this time. These unseen portraits and a large selection of his best work for the NME make up this Retrospective.

The 2015 Bridgend CC 5 to 8 Competition

The 23rd March saw the judging of the 2015 Bridgend CC 5 to 8 Competition. This year's competition attracted a record number of sequences, with entries from all parts of the UK, South Africa and Norway. The sequences covered a number of themes and ideas reflecting the international nature of the authors. Animal life varied from the wildlife of Africa's Etosha National Park via the sheep of North Wales to the polar bears of arctic Svalbard. The wild landscapes of Iceland and Scotland were counterbalanced by the more gentle and pastel landscapes of England and Wales. Tasked with the not inconsiderable job of providing a critique of over thirty entries and selecting the winning sequences was this year's judge Malcolm Imhoff FRPS FACI(M). Malcolm's comments and suggestions were all given in a positive and constructive way intended to help the competitor polish and improve the techniques used. I would like to thank Malcolm for the not inconsiderable work that was required to critique the sequences and provide us with such a fulfilling event. The following sequences proved successful:

Advice from Ed Cloutman

Is your PC or laptop running slow? If so it could be full of Adobe cache files if you run Photoshop or Bridge on it. First check how full the drive is by opening 'My Computer' and right clicking on the C:\ drive. Go to 'Properties', and if it is over 3/4 full it MAY be cache related.

Then check the following: C:\Users\Ed(the name of your personal folder)\AppData\Roaming\Adobe\Bridge CS5.1 (or your version)\Cache

Right click on the cache folder and see how full it is - mine was over 40GB!

If you only have one hard drive then the best option is to clear the cache. This is achieved thus:
Open Adobe Bridge > Edit > Preferences > Cache Press the 'Purge Cache' button.

If you have a separate or partitioned hard drive in your PC then this is much better as you can load programs on the C:\ drive and keep your data and cache on the internal hard drive.

Make a new folder on the internal drive and call it 'Adobe Bridge Cache'.
You now need to redirect your caches thus:

Open Photoshop > Edit > Preferences > Performance > change the scratch disc folder by un-ticking the C:\ drive box and ticking your other internal drive box.

After purging your C:\ drive in Bridge as described above open the same window and press the 'Choose' button and locate the new folder you made on your internal drive. Your cache is now redirected.

You can redirect to an external drive, but it may be slower and it will always have to be connected and switched on. Finally to check that all the cache has been removed you will need to open 'My Computer' as described at the start of these notes.

You can safely manually delete these files as the folders are remade every time you open 'Bridge'.

More Information from Rob Ashcroft

Ed's piece about cache was useful. But in order to see my app-data files I had to change my windows file viewer to see system files. I did that by going into TOOLS\FOLDER OPTIONS\VIEW of the viewer. I'm on Windows 7. I don't think that was mentioned and it might confuse some people.

If you use multiple Bridge versions, or just have them on your PC it's best to load each version and delete the cache as they are separate files. My CC Bridge was 11GB and my CS6 version was 9GB. Deleting both will only improve performance of the one you use (say CC version) but will save overall disk space when both are deleted.
